- 2. We can collect and send **tangible goods**. These are the items that shelters have identified as being top priority items:
  - Blankets
  - Pillows
  - Towels
  - Socks
  - Baby Food/Formula/Bottles
  - Baby Wipes
  - Toothbrush/Toothpaste
  - Sneakers/Shoes/Flip Flops
  - Jackets/Sweatshirts
