"Fake it 'til you make it" is common counsel given to those struggling with self-doubt. But do we actually need to fake it, or can we instead cultivate true, evidence-based confidence? High achievers and those in certain fields (like lawyers) are at unique risk of this often-hidden epidemic and suffer a greater sense of isolation and anxiety as a result. Women, racialized people, and other marginalized populations often experience Imposter Syndrome as a form of internalized bias. Participants will learn actionable tactics to recognize and address limiting beliefs within themselves—and each other—and thus better know their own unique value and how they can successfully engage that value in their careers and lives.
